TARIFF UPDATE ANNOUNCEMENT

July 31, 2020

RE: Advice No. 20-08, NEW Schedule 14 Residential Battery Energy Storage Pilot

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon approved the following sheets to PGE's Retail Tariff which are effective on **August 1, 2020**:

Twenty Fifth Revision of Sheet No. 1-1
Original Sheet No. 14-1
Original Sheet No. 14-2
Original Sheet No. 14-3
Original Sheet No. 14-4

This approved filing establishes a new Schedule 14, a Residential Battery Energy Storage Pilot. The pilot targets 525 (2-4 MW or 6-8MWh) controllable behind-the-meter energy storage systems in residential homes. The pilot's purpose is to explore the ability of distributed assets to provide grid services, learn how to deploy assets with benefit streams shared between participants and all PGE customers, and develop best practices for integrating distributed resources into existing assets control systems. The pilot will test customer acceptance of utility operation of batteries, explore hurdles to adoption, and help to understand residential resiliency needs. For participation in the pilot, customers are eligible to receive an incentive. This pilot is expected to be conducted through July 31, 2025.
