Advice No. 20-25, Schedule 4, Multifamily Water Heater Pilot Extension: This approved filing extends the Multifamily Residential Demand Response Water Heater, also known as Multifamily Water Heater (MFWH) pilot, from September 30, 2020 through January 31, 2021.

Advice No. 20-26, Schedule 26, Nonresidential Demand Response Program Update: This approved filing changed Schedule 26 that was set to expire on September 30, 2020 from a pilot status to a program, in addition to housekeeping items to streamline language.

Advice No. 20-27, Updating Schedule 25, Nonresidential Direct Load Control Pilot Term Extension: This approved filing extends the term of Schedule 25 from September 30, 2020 through December 31, 2020, in addition to housekeeping items to streamline language.
