Advice No. 20-22, Schedule 136 Oregon Community Solar Program Cost Recovery Mechanism Methodology of Bill Credits: This approved filing revises Schedule 136, Oregon Community Solar Program's (CSP) Cost Recovery Mechanism, to recover costs incurred during and for the development and/or modification of the Oregon CSP that are not otherwise included in rates and to spread these costs across all cost of service and direct access customers.

Advice No. 20-28, Schedule 5 Residential Direct Load Control Pilot Update: This approved filing updates Schedule 5 to provide the flexibility PGE needs to act on improving customer awareness and participation for the pilot and clarifies the intent of a payback mechanism.

Advice No. 20-29, Schedule 125 – West Side Hydro Facilities Planned Maintenance Outage Updates in the November 6, 2020 Net Variable Power Cost update: This approved filing modifies the language of Schedule 125, allowing PGE to finalize 2021 planned maintenance outages for West Side hydro facilities in its November 6, 2020, Net Variable Power Cost Update.
