<b>What is the contract length?</b>	Green Future Solar contract is month to month.
<b>How much will Green Future Solar cost?</b>	\$5.00 per block of Green Future Solar.
<b>Will my rates change over time?</b>	Green Future Solar prices are based on current Oregon Public Utility Commission approved tariffs. Pricing is subject to change. All price changes require approval from the OPUC. Customers will be notified of any price change in advance.
<b>What are the enrollment options?</b>	Green Future Solar is available in 1 kW solar blocks at a cost of \$5.00 per block. A customer can elect to purchase as many as they wish, with a minimum purchase of one block. In order to enroll, customers may do so via self-service on PGE's website, via our call center on the phone, or in person via face to face outreach.
<b>What other fees might I be charged?</b>	You must also pay all applicable federal, state or local taxes.
<b>How will I be billed?</b>	Your Green Future Solar charge will be listed as a separate line item on your monthly PGE electricity bill. This charge is in addition to your regular electricity bill.
<b>Can I cancel my participation?</b>	You can cancel at any time with no fee. There is no minimum contract length.
<b>If I want to terminate this agreement/contract, what is the early termination fee?</b>	You can cancel at any time with no fee. There is no minimum contract length.
<b>What is a REC product?</b>	Green Future Solar is a Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) product and does not contain electricity. A REC is created when a megawatt hour of renewable energy is produced and delivered to the grid. RECs increase demand and drive development of more renewable energy sources. All RECs purchased on behalf of Green Future Solar customers conform to Green-e <sup>®</sup> Energy National Standards and are registered with the Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System (WREGIS). Our Green Future Solar customers' renewable purchases support Western region-supplied new renewable energy.
